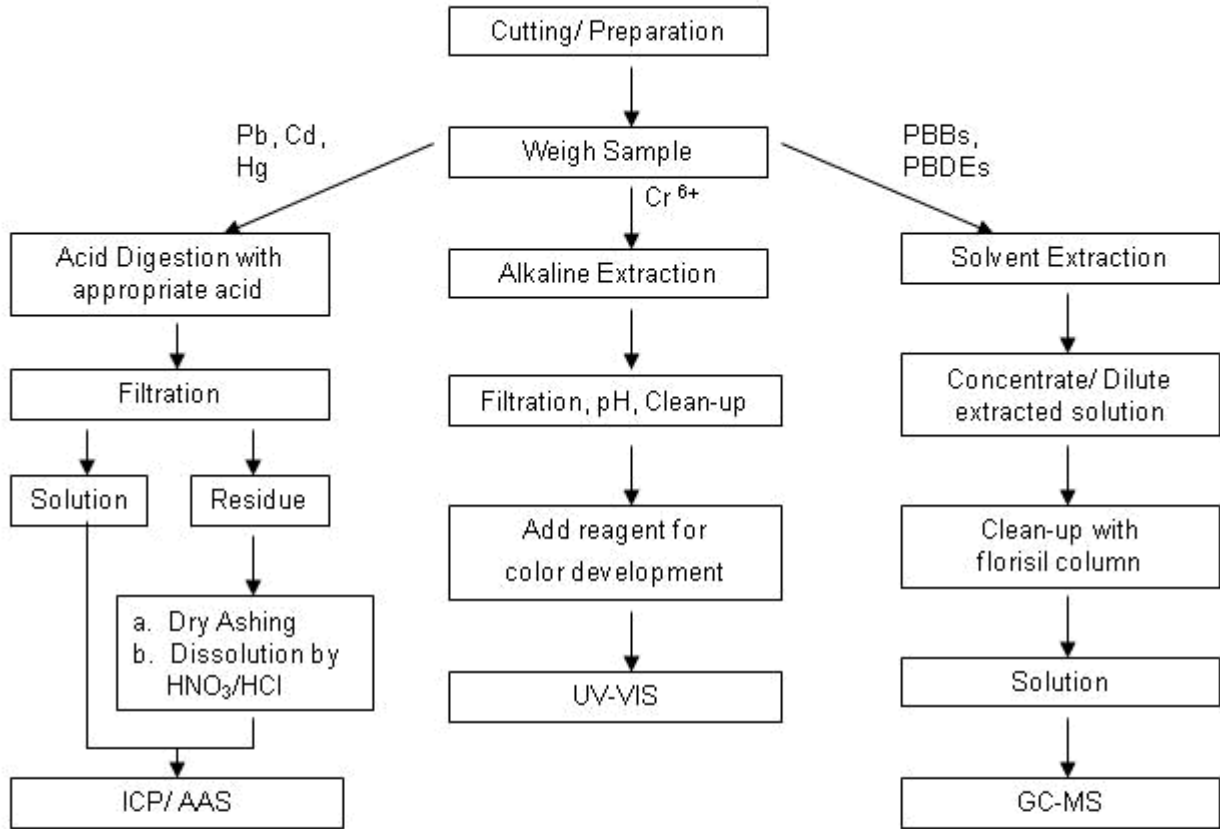

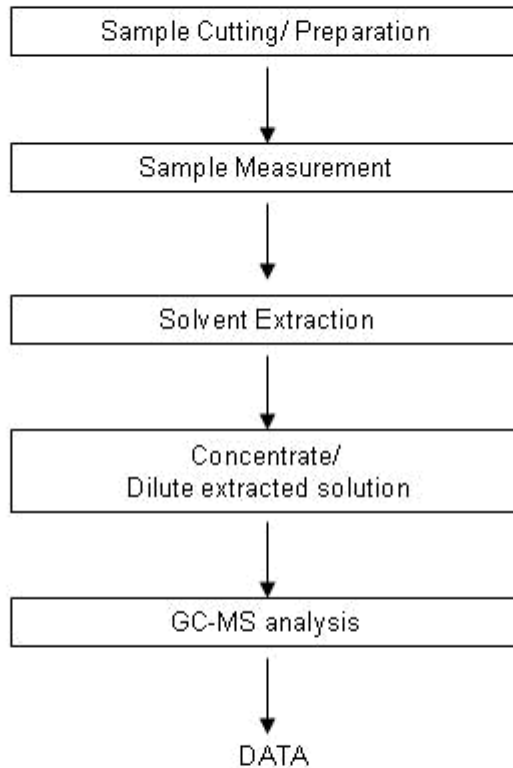

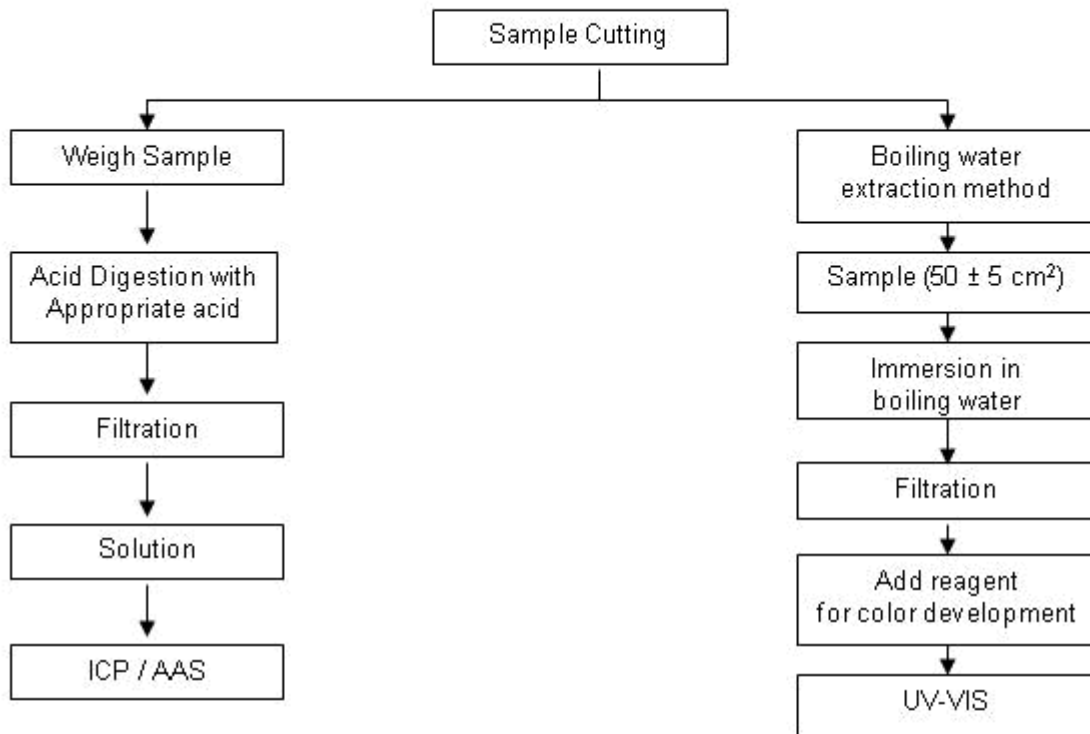

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Flowchart of IEC 62321 for metal analysis



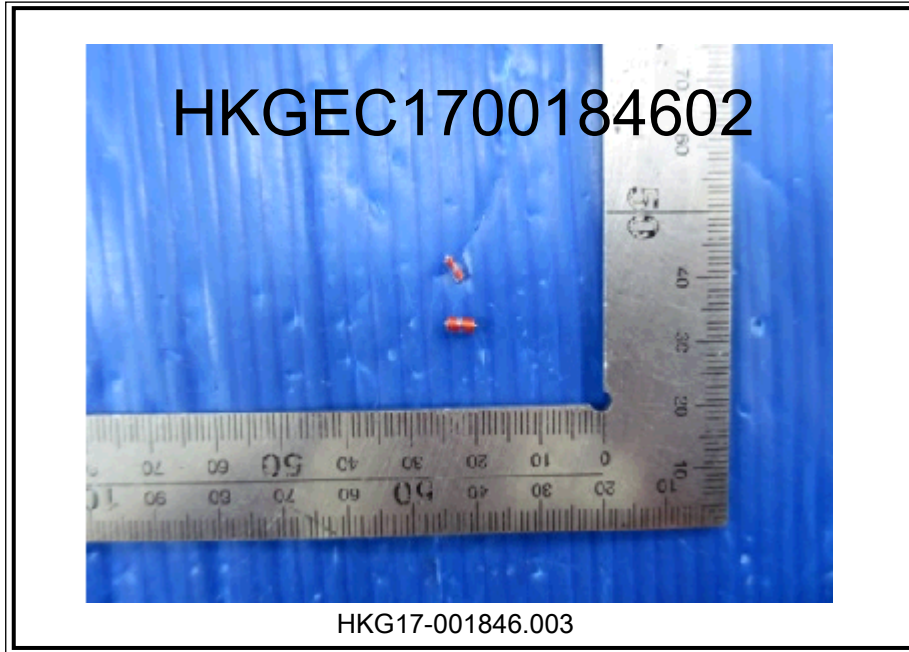
