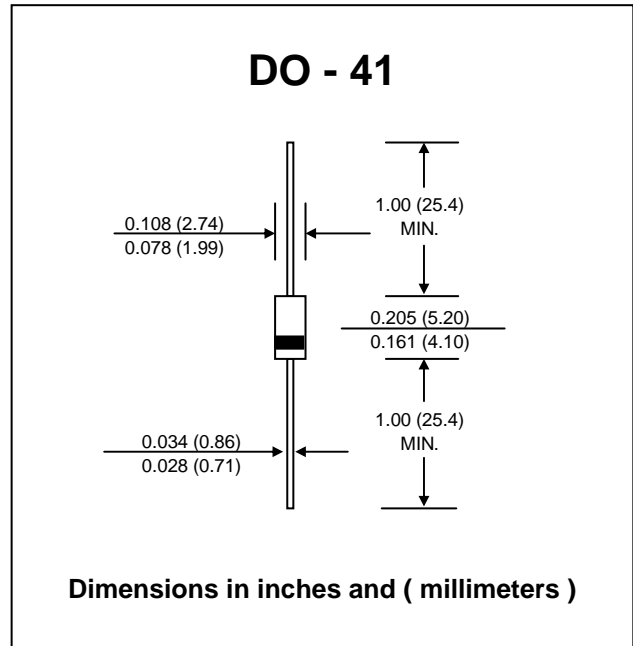

FIG.1 - REVERSE RECOVERY TIME CHARACTERISTIC AND TEST CIRCUIT DIAGRAM

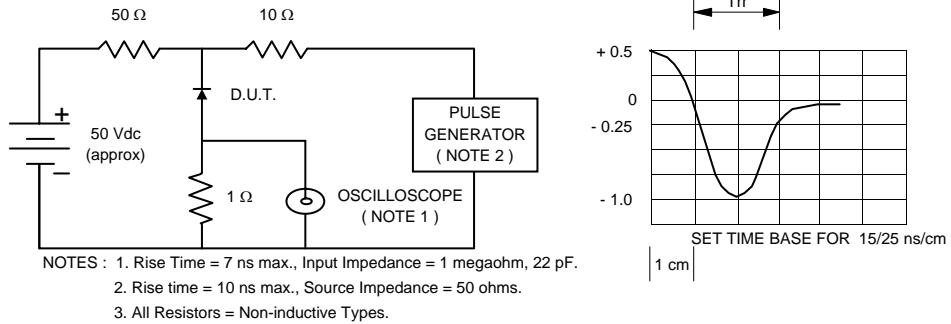


FIG. 2 - DERATING CURVE FOR OUTPUT RECTIFIED CURRENT

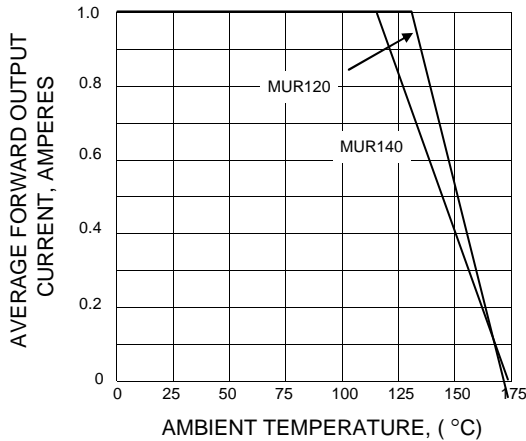


FIG. 3 - MAXIMUM NON-REPETITIVE PEAK FORWARD SURGE CURRENT

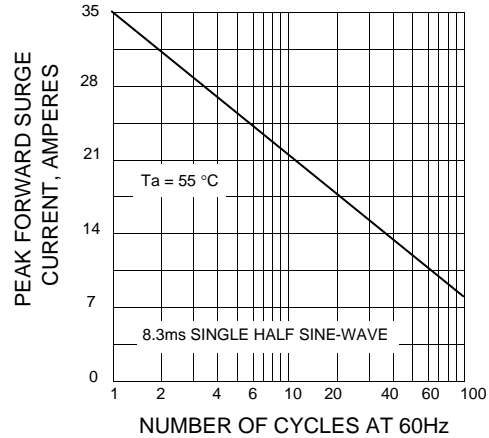


FIG. 4 - TYPICAL FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS

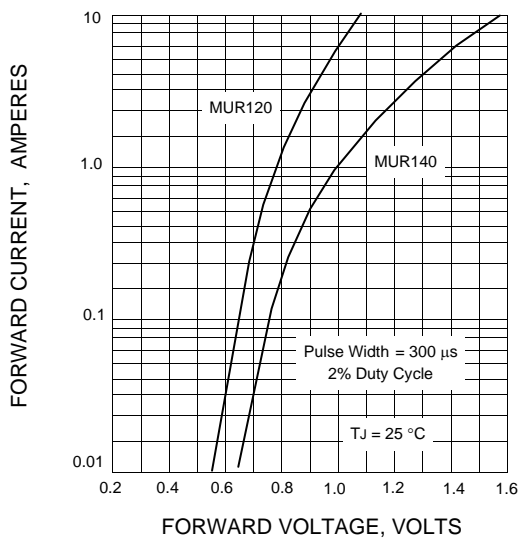


FIG. 5 - TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTICS
